## F. SCOTT AND ZELDA FITZGERALD MUSEUM- MONTGOMERY

The F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald Museum is the only museum dedicated to the lives and legacies of F. Scott & Zelda Fitzgerald in the world. The Fitzgeralds lived here from 1931 until 1932, writing portions of their respective novels, *Save Me The Waltz* and *Tender Is The Night* during their time in Montgomery.

## TUSKEGEE ARMEN NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE- TUSKEGEE

Before the first African American military pilots became known as the "Red Tails" they wore striped tails as they began their flight training in the Army's PT-17 Stearman bi-plane. Their flying adventure started at Moton Field, in Tuskegee, Alabama, where the Army Air Corps began a military "experiment" to see if Negroes could be trained to fly combat aircraft.
